A visit to the Billingsgate Roman Baths Tuesday, 11th June, 11am Optional lunch after the visit at Davy's Restaurant, Plantation Place

If you have not visited the City's own Roman Baths in Lower Thames Street, then this is an event not to be missed.



The ruins were discovered in 1848 when the Coal Exchange was built on the site. The bath and hypocausts are clearly visible and a **specialist** guide will take us on a journey through time and explain everything there is to know about this unique site.

The visit will be approximately 1 hour and involves traversing down stairs to Roman London which is approximately 20 feet under street level at this point. The cost for the tour is £20 per person including VAT.
